

Fine and Designed Carrot Market Details

The Carrot's new and improved market will be featuring about 4-5 of Edmonton's Artists and Artisans on the last Saturday of each month. We have now become a juried show.

The market will run on the last Saturday of each month from 12-4pm. The Artist/ Artisan will be responsible for their own display. We will provide tables available for you and they will be assigned by The Carrot Manager. If you have specific questions with regards to set up please contact Irene Yauck at the Carrot 471-1580.

The Carrot will take a commission of 20% (with a cap of \$35 dollars) or will accept volunteer hours in lieu of commission. Volunteering can range from doing a shift at the carrot to other volunteering needs of The Carrot. If you choose to volunteer we will need to know that in advance to schedule in and get training if need be.

We will put out a call for each season. (**Spring** – March, April, May. **Summer** – June, July, August. **Fall** – September, October, November. **Christmas** – we will run every weekend in December before the 25th). **Please note that we will take a break from the market in January and February.**

In addition to each season of Arts Markets, we will be offering an “Anything Goes” Market. This will offer a chance for new and upcoming artists and artisans to wet their feet as well as artists that might not make the juried selection process to display and sell their creations.

Please contact me if you are interested in submitting, give a description of what you do (send pictures if possible), specify dates that would work for you or if you just have any questions at all. Please forward this to any other artists and artisans you think might be interested in participating.

We promote the artists and artisans via our email-outs and our website so we will ask you to get in touch with the other volunteers that take care of that. We do some advertising but we do rely mainly on word of mouth promotion as well so anything that you can do to promote yourself that would be great.
